TfL Commitment 5: dog walking

October 2013

1. Context

There is a dog walking area within the northern boundary of Kennington Park (owned by the London Borough of Lambeth). As a result of the TWAO, this dog walking area would be temporarily relocated. TfL has agreed a position with the London Borough of Lambeth (as owners of the Park).

2. Proposed commitment

TfL and the London Borough of Lambeth have agreed that TfL will fund the costs for Lambeth to:

- temporarily relocate the current dog walking area to an area of the park adjacent to the Brixton Road (please see the map below);
- maintain the temporary dog walking area;
- relocate the dog walking area to the current location, after the works; and
- reinstate the temporary area.

3. How the commitment will be secured

TfL and the London Borough of Lambeth (as the owners of Kennington Park and authority responsible for the management of the park) are entering into a legal agreement which includes all points set out in 2 above.

This legal agreement will form part of TfL's contract documentation for construction of the railway and it will be a legal requirement for the contractor to comply with the provisions in this agreement.
