Summary

Transport Crime in London

The information presented in this bulletin covers I April 2020 – 3I March 202I; an extraordinary year in which the covid-I9 pandemic had a devastating impact on the use of public transport due to national restrictions and changes to people's working and travel patterns. The first national lockdown commenced on 23 March 2020 with the general public advised to stay at home and avoid using public transport. National regulations and guidance remained in place for much of the year which meant that the volume of passengers using public transport in 2020/2I was significantly lower than previous years. This extraordinary year had an unprecedented impact on passenger ridership and both the volume and rate of crime on our public transport networks.

The average daily journeys on public transport fell from 10.5 to 3.5 million – a 66 per cent reduction compared to 2019/20. Levels of transport crime more than halved during the same period. While the volume of offences was significantly lower, we did see an increase in the rate of crime per million passenger journeys. Crime types that are normally associated with busy commuter rush hours such as theft, low-level violence and aggression (pushing and shoving) and sexual offences all saw reductions.

Throughout this extraordinary year, our police partners continued to provide dedicated policing for our public transport networks to keep staff and customers safe. In addition to activity to prevent and investigate transport crime and safeguard the most vulnerable customers, they also provided essential support for enforcing and encouraging compliance with public health measures (stay at home, social distancing and face covering requirements) to keep everyone safe.

In terms of transport crime, our focus with the Metropolitan Police Roads and Transport Policing Command (RTPC) and the British Transport Police (BTP) continued to be on high harm offences including sexual offences, hate crime, serious violence, keeping knives off the network and tackling violence and aggression against our frontline transport workers. We continue to work with the RTPC and BTP to support London's recovery by keeping the network safe and feeling safe for customers and staff.




Total Crime (by Type)



Police data shows that there were 19,521 crimes recorded for TfL's public transport networks. Crime fell by 52 per cent (21,449 fewer offences) compared to 2019/20.

Crime Rate


Crimes per million passenger journeys

The large increase in 2020/21 in crime rates is due to the significant decrease in passenger volumes.
