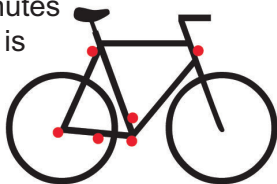

Register

Register your bike at www.immobilise.com.

It only takes a couple of minutes and it's FREE. All you need is your bicycle model, make and frame number (red dots indicate where you can find this).



Once you have registered your bike, you will have a better chance of getting it back if it is lost or stolen. You can also register other property at the same time, for example your mobile phone.

Report

If your bike is lost or stolen, report it to the police and flag it as stolen on your account on the register as soon as possible.

Reporting your bike as lost or stolen helps the police match its description and return it to you.

Reunite

If your bike is recovered you will be contacted and told it's safe. Remember the best chance you have of getting your bike back is to register it.
