1 Summary

3 Background

- 3.1 The main matters considered by the Panel were:

 - (d) Quarterly Resilience Report; and
 - (e) Independent Adviser Appointments to the Panel.

4 Issues Discussed

Quarterly Health, Safety and Environment Performance Reports for Quarter 4, 2012/13

- 4.1 The Panel noted the quarterly HSE reports for Quarter 4, 2012/13, for London Underground, Surface Transport, London Rail, Crossrail and the Corporate directorates. Items discussed included:
 - (a) activities taking place to manage Signals Passed at Danger on the London Overground network;
 - (b) work to identify broken rails on the London Underground network;
 - (c) recent cycling fatalities at Holborn and Aldgate. The Panel offered its full support for activities to further improve safety for cyclists in London;

- (d) the review of accessibility at Crossrail stations and the opportunities for potential improvements; and
- (e) the Panel congratulated the Occupational Health team on receiving the Healthy Workplace Charter award.

Forward Look Agenda Plan – July 2013 – March 2015

4.2 The Panel noted the paper, which provided an outline of items to be presented to future meetings of the Panel. In addition, the Panel requested a strategic away day to allow more general discussions around some of the items.
