11.20 arrives at 12.30.

16.40 arrives at 18.10.

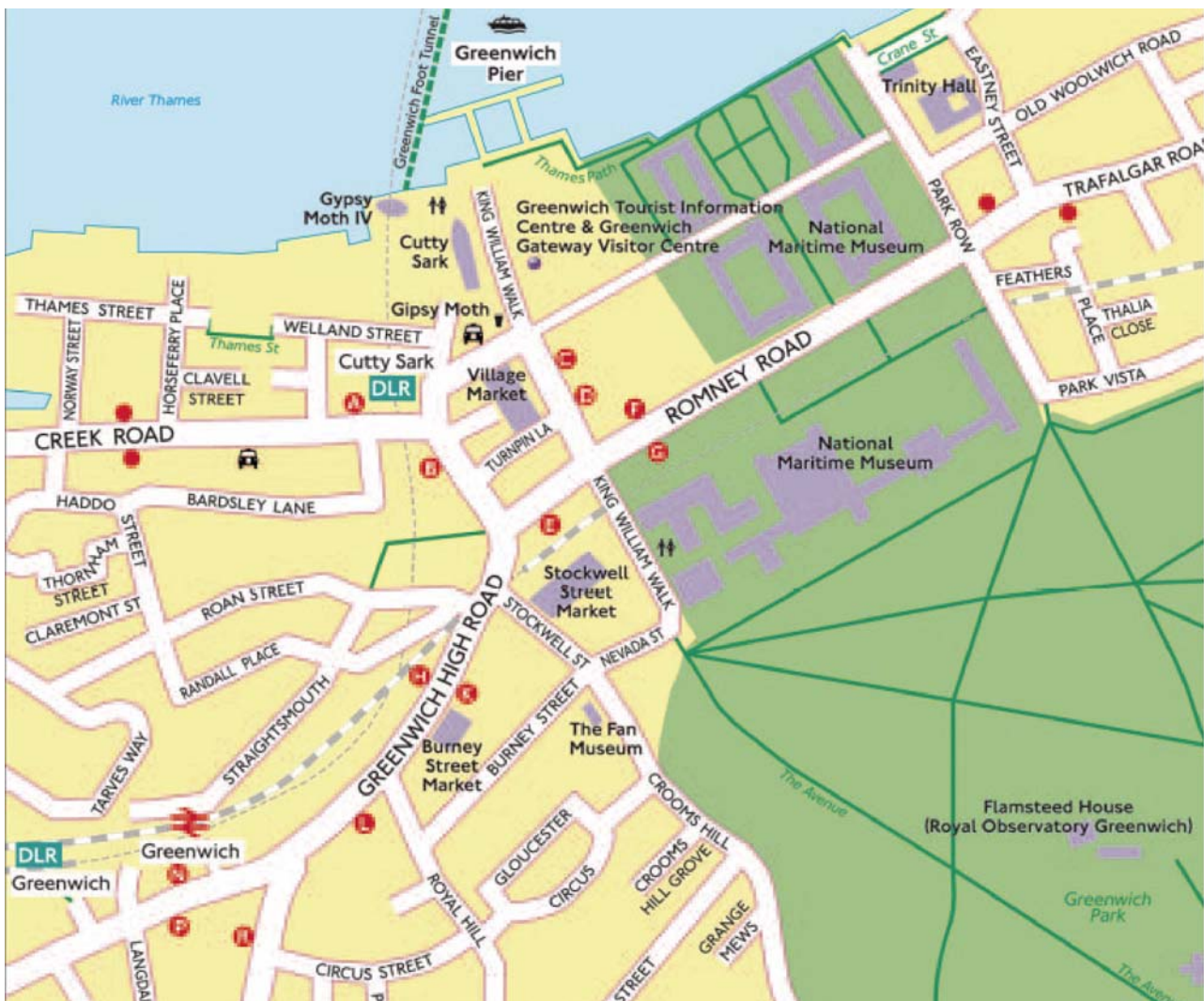
Once the Delawares arrive at Greenwich Pier they have several places of interest they would like to visit.

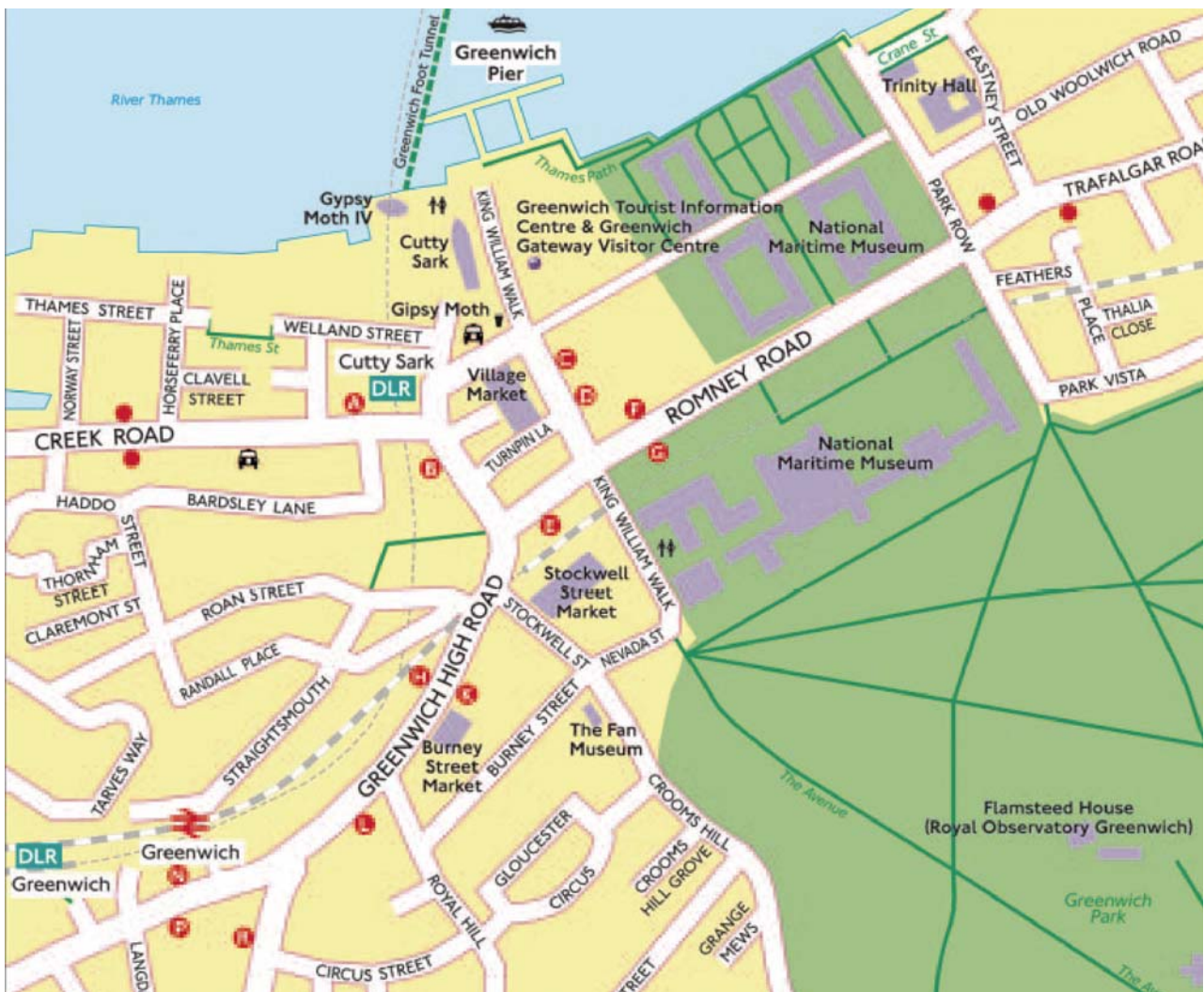
